

Official Bulletin for the 2. International 16-way Cup 2016 in Saarlouis

Target: To determine the performance levels of the competing teams.

To promote and develop Formation Skydiving.

To present a visually attractive image of the competition jumps and

standings (scores) for competitors, spectators and media.

To exchange ideas and strengthen friendly relations between the sport

parachutists, judges, and support personnel.

Dates/Schedule: Friday, 30.09.2016: training jumps from 09.00 hrs. possible. Appr.

20.00 hrs. announcement of draw and competitors meet.

Saturday, 01.10.2016: start of competition at 09.00 hrs., from 20.00

hrs. on dinner and party.

Sunday, 02.10.2016: continuation of competition jumps from 09.00

hrs. to 20.00 hrs.

Monday, 03.10.16: is a public holiday in Germany. End of competition

appr. 16.00 hrs., prize giving ceremony appr. 17.00 hrs.

Aircraft: 2 Cessna 208 (Grand) Caravan ,Supervan 900'. The competition will be

held out of 2 aircraft flying in close formation. All 16-way teams will be split in one group of 9 jumpers in the lead plane and a second group of 7 jumpers in the trail plane. Per flight 2 16-way teams will be lifted.

Videophotographers of the two teams will be split, one being in the lead plane, one being in the trail plane.

Both aircraft have identical light signals. Red light meaning appr. "2 minutes to drop/standby", the green light meaning "open the door and exit".

General Rules:

This 16-way Cup is scheduled of 10 rounds. The draw will partially consist of formations from the official 16-way dive pool but will also contain some "newly created" formations. Each round will consist of 3-4 formations.

The exit altitude will be 4.000 meters AGL / 13.000 feet with a working time of 50 seconds. For meteorologial reasons the meet director may decide to lower the exit altitude to 2.000 meters AGL / 6.500 feet with a working time of 20 seconds.

Other than the examples stated above the FAI rules and IPC regulations will apply for scoring formations and the determination of the winner of this 16-way Cup.

Entry Fee: 510,00 Euro (17 x 30,00 Euro) per team. This contains dinner on

Saturday evening at the DZ, presents and an organisation fee. Entry fee

needs to be paid in cash before the competition starts.

Jump prices: 464,00 Euro (16 x 29,00 Euro) per team and jump (incl. video). Jump

tickets can be paid either cash, by Maestro or credit card.

Judge: Will be announced before the competition.
